Director's Note

In early 2022, we resumed rehearsals after being interrupted for a month yet again because of COVID, and once again, it cost us our season-end musical. At the same time as we were putting together a substitute cabaret show, we were trying to choose our shows for our 2022-2023 season. It was important to us that we let the kids have a big say in what we were going to do. For two years, they'd been hearing a lot of "no." Much had been stolen from them over the past two years, and they had still pulled together and accomplished so much. We owed them a YES.

Shrek the Musical is an ambitious undertaking. It's a big, complicated show, with challenging music, an enormous cast, and it was going to demand a lot from all of us, but when the kids resoundingly asked to do this show, we said YES, and we didn't look back.

We are *always* proud of these kids. We are proud of kids who sing in the shower every day, deafening their families with practice. We are proud of kids who stretch themselves, who put themselves out there, who dare to get on stage and make big things happen for themselves and with their fellow cast members. We are proud of the kids who step forward as dance captains and junior choreographers, who take it upon themselves to make props, who put in the work, and who grow in this program. We are *always* proud.

Shrek is all about trust and faith in one another, looking beyond the obvious and seeing the possibilities in one another and in our *connections* with one another. Day after day, I see our good people reaching out to one another in trust and faith, making connections that will strengthen all of us throughout our lives. This project has taught us to dig in and rely on one another in a hundred valuable ways, and I believe we are all the richer for it.

It takes a village to raise a child; it takes an army to put 39 of them on stage for a full-length musical production. Please take the time to look through this programme, and to recognise and appreciate the army of people that have come together to help these kids shine in our production of Shrek The Musical.

I hope very much that you enjoy the fruit of all our labour over these past many months. Thank you for joining us.

Then he vanished into the night before he could be publicly thanked, which is how he wanted it.


